***It is the intended that this table reflects USEA rules for the USEA divisions, the rules will be updated as USEA rules change.

Other Requirements

Any area not specifically mention in the SCDCTA Show Organization materials will automatically fall under the rules listed in the US Equestrian Federation (USEF) Rule Book for the current year. A copy of the rule book can be obtained by calling the USEF at 1.859.258.2472 or can be downloaded off the USEF website at www.usef.org.

A 20 m x 60m regulation dressage arena is REQUIRED in order to offer USDF tests at First Level and above and/or to offer combined training divisions above the Preliminary Level.

Horses are limited to a maximum of three (3) dressage tests per day at Fourth Level and below or two (2) tests per day above Fourth Level or two (2) combined training divisions per day. Horses may enter no more than two (2) consecutive levels per competition.

The SCDCTA high and low score ribbons can only be awarded to a current SCDCTA member in good standing. The Dressage High Score Ribbon is to be awarded to the rider with highest dressage score at Training Level or above.
