Listed above are the points that will be awarded to calculate Year End Awards.

Year End Awards will be awarded to the following categories:

- ❖ Advanced
- ❖ Intermediate
- ❖ Preliminary
- ❖ Training
- ❖ Novice
- ❖ Beginner Novice
- ❖ Tadpole

Awards are given to Rider/Horse teams that acquire a minimum of 2 scores for each level. Each category will be split by adult amateur, junior/young rider and open divisions.

Combined Training awards are separate from Horse Trial awards.

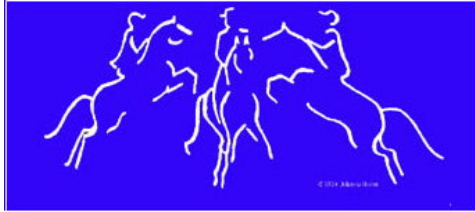
If a class is split into several smaller classes, points will be given as if they were one class.

Rider is responsible for informing Point Coordinator about out of state show results.

Horse and rider must be SCDCTA members at the time the scores are earned.

I will do my best to track in-state Combined Training and Horse Trial events. Although, it would be in the riders best interest to e-mail me with the show information and their results as I would hate to accidentally miss one.

Medal Program

Certificate of Achievement

Awarded for completing five (5) horse trials at any level Tadpole-Advanced. This is a horse award and one certificate per level can be earned.

Blue Ribbon

Awarded to the rider for placing 1st through 6th at three (3) Beginner Novice level horse trials.

Medallion Award

Awarded to the rider for placing 1st through 6th at three (3) Novice level horse trials.

Bronze Medal

Awarded to the rider for placing 1st through 6th at three (3) Training level horse trials.

Silver Medal

Awarded to the rider for placing 1st through 6th at three (3) Preliminary level horse trials, including two-day events, and one-star three day events.

Gold Medal

Awarded to the rider for placing 1st through 6th at three (3) Intermediate or Advanced level Horse Trials, including two-day events, and three and four star three-day events.

Requirements for earning and submitting scores

1. Scores may be used beginning with the 2007 competition year
2. The fronts of score sheets **MUST** be photocopied and the following information **MUST** be included: horse's name, rider, date, score, name of show (must be SCDCTA or USEA) and test used, dressage score and overall penalty points.
3. Riders **MUST** be members of SCDCTA at the time at which the penalty points were earned.
4. When complete, riders must submit SCDCTA Horse Trial Awards Form, Test sheets and send to current CT/Horse Trial Coordinator.
5. Awards may be on more than one horse (with the exception of the Certificate of Achievement).
6. There is no time limit as to when the scores have to be earned.
